3. President's Report

The Club's operation since the last AGM has continued to see transitions and challenges. The Management Committee members have put in many hours of work towards improving the Club's identity, services and environment for members, staff and volunteers.

I would like to briefly report on several aspects of Club outcomes over the past twelve months and over the financial year.

Gymnastic Results

Again, Club gymnasts have enjoyed excellent results in both ACT and National competitions. Again, I am happy to say that these are too many to mention individually in the body of this report but are presented in tabular form at the end.

The year began with CCGC gymnasts Zoe and Anthea Hewett competing in California during January as members of the Australian level 10 team. Anthea returned with two Silver medals for Bars.

The Club participated in all the Australian Levels Program (ALP) competitions held in the ACT and was again a strong presence both in numbers and results.

Almost all gymnasts took part in the suite of level one to level 4 Womens Artistic Gymnastics (WAG), Mens Artistic Gymnastics (MAG) and Trampoline competitions with many achieving Gold and Red ribbons. In the ALP level 5 to level 10, our gymnasts regularly featured in the top three with Emma Carters becoming the level 10 winner. This year the Club also participated in an invitational competition held by Canberra Trampoline Sports Club. CCGC's Jeremy Neideck won his level resoundingly.

In the National stream the ACT Gymnastic Association brought in a further change to the ACT competition structure with the entry to National stream competition being at level 2.

Our Womens Artistic Gymnasts (WAG) again performed very well being the majority of the Red and Gold recipients at the final Grading. The level 4 to level 10 championships saw our teams competing at their new levels very well. Phillipa Dickens, Jessica Ingersole, Miyoko Holder and Natasha Schumacher became ACT level 5, level 6, level 8 and level 9 Champions respectively.

CCGC gymnasts representing the ACT at Australian Championships *all* qualified for 'finals'. Top six results were: Zoe Hewett, level 10, Australian Silver medallist on Bars and 6th overall, Anthea Hewett, level 10, 5th on Vault. Notable was Lauren Donne's nomination, alongside international Allana Slater, for the Sussman Award for artistic dance in the floor exercise.

At National Clubs level 4 and level 6 teams won several top six awards. Level 4 and level 7 gymnasts new to the experience of junior (National Clubs – L4 to L6) and senior National competitions were again well supported by teammates and Club mates.

Retirements

We farewelled long serving gymnasts Svetlana Kostenko (L10) and Miyoko Holder (L8). We welcome Svetlana and Miyoko to our coaching staff.

Staff

Transitions continued here with Alexander Kostenko announcing his departure after Australian Championships early June 2002. We were very fortunate to attract Qu Derui, a very highly regarded coach in Australia and internationally, to take up the position of Head Coach from 1st July. Our National program has been strengthened with Derui's appointment and better places the Club to contribute to Gymnastics Australia's changing national and state competition program and format, currently under consideration.

Zoe Hewett, assistant and relief tots coach for term 2, departed to start University studies and join the gymnastics squad at Boise State, Idaho USA.

Sadly, Renee Frost, our tots and schools coach departed soon after and suddenly in term 3 due to personal reasons. Several coaches supported the Club during a very difficult time filling in whenever asked. Thank you to Brian Hewett, Thuy Anh Phan, Kimiko Holder, Amy Doolan and Kelly Young.

The Committee has continued its policy to encourage personal and professional development for all staff by subsidising course fees and travel as well as holding regular in-Club workshops with guest presenters. We are also pursuing new coaches and a recent advertisement in the Canberra Times has attracted several promising responses.

Membership

Membership numbers have fluctuated seasonally but average around 650 for the year including children participating in our Schools program. The Committee's aim is certainly to maintain these numbers, which are almost optimal for the physical size of the Club.

Schools Program

Our partnership with Southern Canberra in the business incorporated as Canberra Gymnastics has been financially successful translating to an income of approximately \$3000 to \$4000 per 10 week term (\$9000 in term 3, 2002). Unfortunately we are unable to fulfil the demand in this area due to lack of coaching personnel.

Congratulations to coaches Renee Frost, Brian Hewett, Kimiko Holder and Thuy Phan for their work in what is a tough gig.

Office & Administration

We now have a full year's operation using the MYOB accounting software, assisted by Jason Webster of Webster Accounting Services. Group certificates were produced electronically this year, saving many hours of handwritten work by the Office Manager. The demands of regular PAYG and BAS calculations have also been alleviated by MYOB. We have also determined to re-investigate the installation of an **EFTPOS** terminal.

The Committee's recent work in streamlining office operations, attending local government and ASC workshops, building a 'corporate' identity wherever possible as well as developing and displaying club policies paid off this year with the Club taking part in Phase 2 of Gymnastics Australia's **Club 10** project. Many hours of quality assurance 'checklist' work have resulted in Canberra City becoming an accredited **Club 10 member** and **Active Australia provider**.

Volunteer Efforts. Grants

Thanks to the volunteer effort of the Club's members, gymnasts, parents, coaches and judges, we again earned future financial support as well as approximately \$4000 for the Club's contribution to the hosting of the Reach for the Stars competition in December 2001 and National Clubs WAG L4 to L6, MAG L1 to L10 and the China v Australia International Competition, held at the AIS Arena in July 2002. Unfortunately, due to an incident resulting in the flooding of the Slam Dunk room, the ACT Association is awaiting advice on insurance excess before distributing any funds.

On a positive note, as the Club's financial position improves we become better placed to apply for local government grants, which normally involve a dollar-for-dollar commitment.

Finance

A landmark outcome in October of this year has been the aquittal of the Club's long term loan with the Commonwealth Bank.

Fees remained static during the financial year but were increased across the board by around 5% this term (term 4). All groups from level 5 and up remain heavily subsidised. *Fees income* has increased, reflecting our increase in members and the improved payment policy for 2002.

On the other side of the ledger.....

Staff Wages (and therefore on-costs such as now-9% superannuation) increased during 2002.

Professional Development, mentioned earlier, has been supported by the Club's policy of full reimbursement of Judges and Coaches course fees on successful completion.

Maintenance and Equipment Purchases are important aspects of current and future expense for Club safety and success. The major purchase this financial year was the Vaulting Table at approximately \$3000. Several equipment upgrades, matting purchases, tumbling floor installation, external signage and new computer purchase since the last AGM currently sum to over \$9000 in expenses.

Referring to the Financial statements.....

The Club has posted an operating surplus, which has been maintained and *increased to this date*. We thank our Officer Manager, Jie Yi Xian and Committee Members for all their contribution to achieve this. This is a particularly pleasing result considering the major expenses incurred to improve all current gymnast members' experience with the Club.

The ATO owes the club for over payment of GST (\$5843). We now calculate the GST payment exactly each quarter.

Liabilities noticeably reduced including provisions for Leave to reflect our current situation (all leave taken).

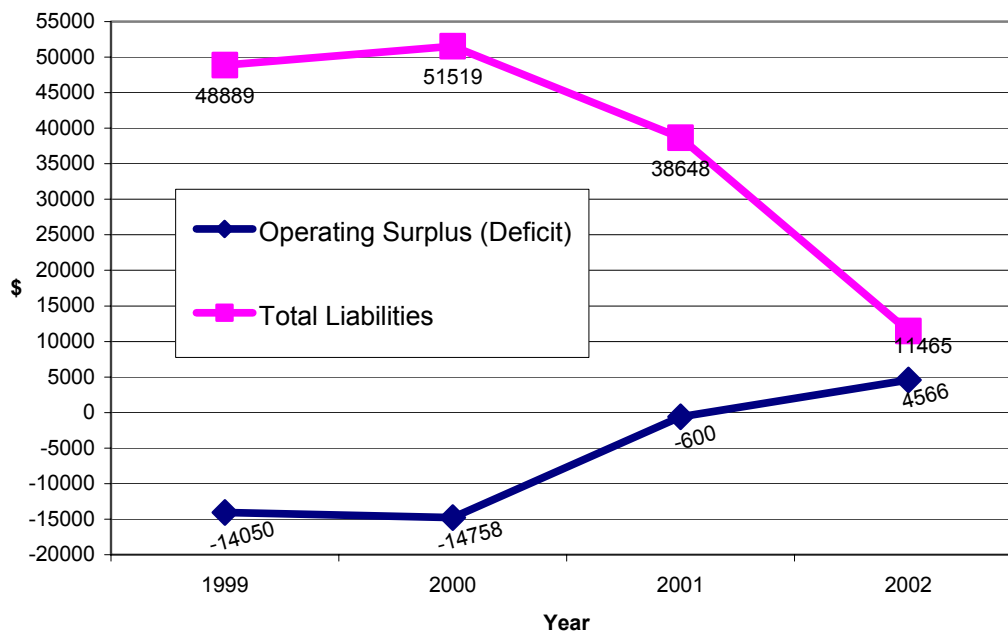
Loan with the Commonwealth bank has been reduced to \$4405 from \$14218
