3. President's Report

I would like to briefly report on several aspects of Club outcomes over the past twelve months and over the financial year. All competition results are attached.

The Club ended the 2002 year with a successful first outing under new head coach Qu Derui. The competition was the National Invitational: Reach for the Stars and results across all levels were outstanding for Canberra City. Members were also involved in two community events. The senior squads enjoyed preparing and delivering a half time display at a Cannons basketball game while a large group of junior gymnasts took part in the inaugural Westfields Christmas Parade. Of course, the final event on the Club's calendar each year is our in-house Christmas Cup competition come display, which again was a lot of fun and a great success.

The defining event for 2003 was the fire on the morning of Friday 7th February. Although the Club's office was completely gutted, the brigade were able to save the rest of the gym. I believe that Canberra's heightened awareness of fire events at this time was reflected in the reporting and the quick response by all concerned. Being the first week of term 1, the Club lost 490 phone calls to the gym, a significant number being enrolment enquiries. None-the-less, prompt action by insurers and Club volunteers had us operational Saturday morning with a trestle table, pencil and paper! The fire also saw the parent community come together with greater fundraising resolve. The return of the Saturday morning sausage sizzle has been welcomed by all. To date, approximately \$3400 has been raised by this event alone. All is well that ends well and, thanks to an enormous effort by the Committee and the office manager, the rebuilding process, which finished only last week, has resulted in a pleasant and professional physical environment matching the administration 'quality' improvements of recent times.

Gymnastic Results

Again, Club gymnasts have enjoyed excellent results in both ACT and National competitions.

The Club entered full contingents to all the ACT Levels Program (ALP) competitions held in the ACT and was again a strong presence both in numbers and results with many MAG and WAG gymnasts achieving Gold and Red ribbons. In the ALP level 5 to level 10, our gymnasts regularly featured in the top three, with Charlotte Churchill winning level 6. This year the Club also participated in the ACT Trampoline State Grading event

Our National Womens Artistic Gymnasts (WAG) again performed very well being the majority of the Red and Gold recipients at the final ACT Grading. The level 4 to level 10 Championships saw our teams competing at their new levels very well. Canberra City won level 4 and 5 (no level 6 team entered) and Melissa Orr, Phillipa Dickens, Lauren Donne and Natasha Schumacher became ACT level 5, level 7, level 8 and level 10 Champions respectively with Natasha Schumacher named ACT Gymnast of the Year (2002-2003), an honour received by our Club gymnasts for many years.

All trialling CCGC gymnasts represented the ACT at Australian Championships and *all* qualified for 'finals' with several top 10 results achieved after the two days of competitions. Notable was Anthea Hewett's nomination, alongside international Lisa Skinner, for the Carole Sussman Award for artistic dance in the floor exercise. This is the second year of this award and both years a Canberra City gymnast has been nominated, last year's nominee being Lauren Donne!

In junior competitions - Level 4 and level 5 gymnasts new to the experience of National L4 to L6 Clubs Championships at the AIS Arena were well supported by teammates and Club mates.

Canberra City's most recent major foray was to Senior Women's National Clubs Championships, Maffra Victoria, where the Club returned with two team bronze medals and a 5th Club placing overall!! Anthea Hewett (level 10) made bars and floor apparatus finals and was named to the Australia B team contesting the Internationals Levels Challenge in December. Our State team competed at Level 8 (Victorian levels) in the parallel State Challenge competition, winning a team gold for vault and team bronze for bars. Overall, this was a great 'camp' for Club gymnasts, officials and chaperones.

A perusal of the year's results may lead one to conclude that the Club has a particular strength on the bars.

Staff

We welcomed the return, in term 1, of long-serving gymnast Louise Cashmere as coach of daytime tots classes, schools classes and the senior ACT levels group. Louise's enthusiasm and professionalism will be sorely missed now that she has returned to the USA.

The Club is also fortunate to have Genevieve Preston, our most successful international athlete, assist in coaching the club's junior squad members this year.

Sadly, we farewelled a valuable coach, judge and Committee member for both the Club and the ACT when Thuy Anh Phan left Canberra to take up a wonderful employment opportunity as a graphic designer in Sydney.

New staff for 2003 include: Tracy Ward as tots and afternoon coach. Tracy also assisted in the office in term 1; and Helen Preston as office assistant in the afternoons since term 2.

The Committee was pleased to achieve formal recognition by Gymnastics Australia of Ludmila Kostenko's Master Coach credentials making Ludmila the Club's fourth senior accredited coach. Also, newly accredited level 1 coaches, Kimiko Holder, Anthea Hewett, Zoe Hewett and Natasha Schumacher are to be congratulated and add to CCGC's substantial number of qualified coaches.

The National program and Club ethos continues to be strengthened under Qu Derui's leadership and encouragement to staff to contribute ideas for improving the Club's operations. We are also indeed fortunate to have the ACT senior WAG levels Judge, Connor Carson, advising the Committee and coaching at the Club.

The Committee has continued its policy to support personal and professional development for all staff by subsidising course fees and travel as well as holding regular in-Club workshops. The challenge for the Committee is to balance the very transient nature of the gymnastics coaching scene with appointments of young professional coaching and administration staff.

Membership

Despite the difficult start to the year, membership numbers have continued to average around 650 for the year including children participating in our Schools program. We believe this can be partly attributed to the re-instatement of our Yellow Pages advertisement as well as the television advertising. The Committee's aim is certainly to maintain these numbers, which are almost optimal for the physical size of the Club. On the other hand, we have been approached by the West Belconnen club, Team Gymnastics, with a proposal to merge with Canberra City. We are currently negotiating staff and administration issues, and are confident that this will be beneficial all involved. PCYC has also approached the Club in relation to their trampoline gymnasts registering with CCGC. Members will be notified about the progress of these ventures through Committee meeting reports.

Schools Program

Our partnership with Southern Canberra in the business incorporated as Canberra Gymnastics has become more or less divided into northside and southside classes with Canberra City being the main provider for Canberra Gymnastics. Currently, the Club services six schools. This is expected to increase to ten schools in 2004 if joint ventures, such as with Team Gymnastics are successful.

Education

Club personnel were involved in the successful Coaches Congress run over the first weekend in February this year. In particular, Qu Derui gave an amazing presentation on the 'hurdle step' preparation for tumbling and Lis Preston was popular with her taping techniques. It was pleasing to see so many young Canberra City coaches attending during this weekend. Thuy Phan and Connor Carson have also readily offered their services during the year for coach and judge education both to the Club and the ACT.

Office & Administration

New staffing arrangements for 2003 have increased weekly office hours to 8 hours per day providing an improved service to members.

Although we would now have a full two year's operation using the MYOB accounting software, assisted by Jason Webster of Webster Accounting Services, the loss of detail from November 2002 to February 2003 (due to the office fire) has meant that some comparison's are still unavailable. None-the-less, the demands of regular PAYG and BAS calculations have been streamlined by MYOB, the full effect of which will be experienced in a less disrupted year.

The installation of an **EFTPOS** terminal was completed last November and was instantly a great success. Re-installation following the fire was, understandably, keenly anticipated and subsequent usage has fully justified this addition to office operations.

The Committee's further streamlining of office operations has led the way in the ACT, with Canberra City becoming the first ACT Club to register athletes and coaches on-line, direct to Gymnastics Australia. Office Manager, Jenny Xian, and assistant Helen Preston have taken on this extra responsibility comfortably.

Volunteer Efforts. Grants

Thanks to the volunteer effort of the Club's members, gymnasts, parents, coaches and judges, we again earned future financial support as well as around \$4400 (\$3700 not yet credited) for the Club's contribution to the hosting of the Reach for the Stars competition in December 2002 and National Clubs WAG L4 to L6 with MAG Championships held at the AIS Arena in July 2003.

Closer to home, the Committee wishes to formally thank the volunteer efforts of Jane Donne and Donna Hopkinson who have been the backbone of the Saturday morning Sausage Sizzles (~\$3400 to date), as well as Donna's and Rosetta Schimizzi's efforts with the Easter and Mother's Day Raffles which combined raised \$744. Thanks must also go to Wests Rugby Club, which has supported the Sausage Sizzles by contributing sausages and bread since March 2003.

More recently Wests have welcomed CCGC as an affiliated club, provided a grant of \$3000 and are preparing two banners for Club display as well as patches for gymnasts. We look forward to what should be a mutually beneficial association.

Finance

A landmark outcome at the end of 2002 was the acquittal of the Club's long term loan with the Commonwealth Bank.

Fees were increased across the board by around 5% in term 4, 2002, and this is reflected by the increased income shown in the profit and loss statement. Increased income also reflects maintained numbers in the Club and the extremely low level of fees outstanding. All groups from level 5 and up remain heavily subsidised.

On the other side of the ledger.....

Staff Wages (and therefore on-costs such as now-9% superannuation) increased in 2003. The Committee also made the decision to pay assistant/apprentice coaches.

Professional Development, mentioned earlier, has been supported by full reimbursement of Senior First Aid course fees following successful completion by two staff members.

Maintenance and Equipment Purchases are important aspects of current and future expense for Club safety and success. The major undertaking this year was the trampoline pit clean and new foam suspension structure, completed over the weekend of January 11th with fantastic volunteer help. The major purchase this financial year was the Uneven Bars in July set at approximately \$3000. Several equipment upgrades, constructions, matting purchases, kitchen improvements make a total of approximately \$10000 expended.

The Committee looks forward to members' input in relation to suggested further improvements for the Club environment.

Referring to the Financial statements.....

The Club has posted an operating surplus, which has been maintained and *increased to this date*. Accounting for wages, PAYG and BAS (about \$16000) now due, the cheque account remains in credit at around \$8000. The school business account also has a balance of approximately \$7000 incorporating term 3 and term 4 deposits. This is a good position for the Club considering the next quarter is lean with respect to fees income.

We thank our Officer Manager, Jie Yi Xian and Committee Members for all their contribution to achieve this. This is a particularly pleasing result considering the events this year and the major expenses incurred to improve all current gymnast members' experience with the Club.

The ATO owes the club for over payment of GST (\$2896). We will now calculate the GST payment exactly each quarter.

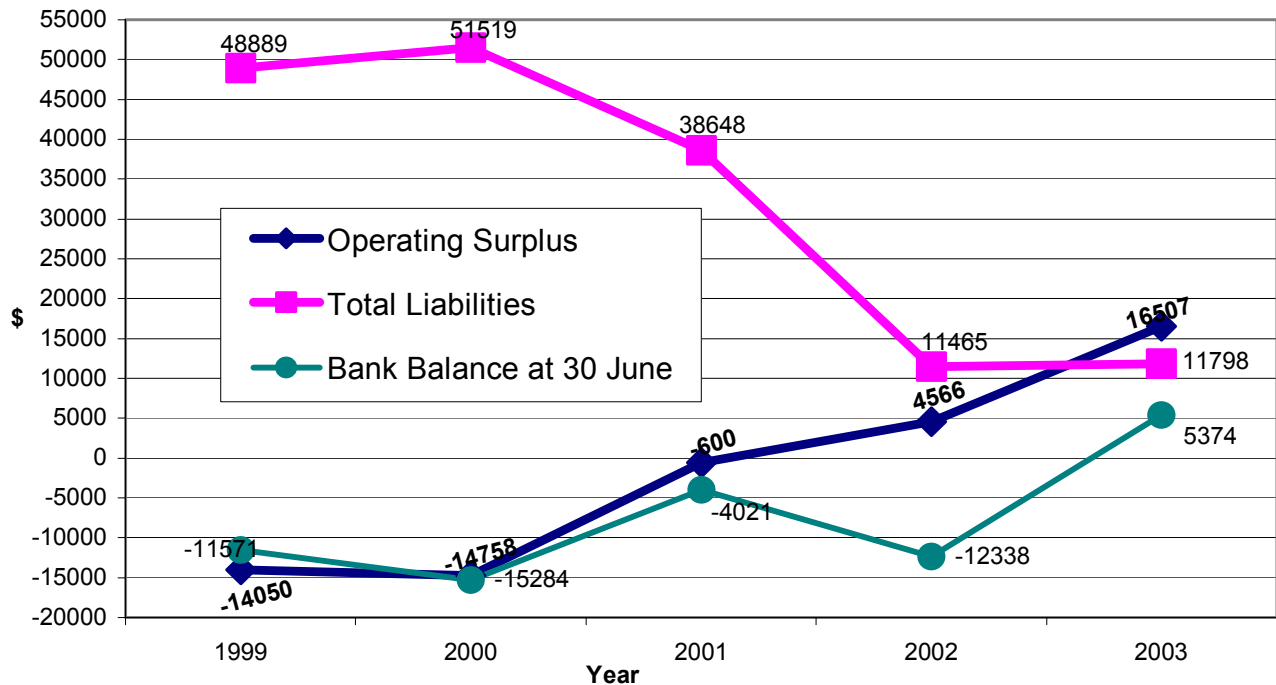
Liabilities as at 30 June 2003, eg: PAYG and BAS, have settled to anticipated levels.

It is worth noting that the bank balance situation as at 30th June 2002 was an outcome partly due to the payment of two sets of head coach wages: for Sasha Kostenko on leave and incoming Qu Derui.
