#### 3. President's Report

The Association continues to strive "to promote and develop the sport of gymnastics in the community and for state and national representation" as required by our constitution.

Participation in our gymsports as well as community use of our facility have continued to increase. The Club has also introduced new programs this year, making gymnastics available to an even broader spectrum of the community.

We have utilized this information to support the Club's application to ACT Sport and Recreation for a Capital Assistance Grant. The plans, which were fully approved for development in July this year, provide for another 120 square metres of floor space.

The Club's second Presentation Night saw the pinnacle Sharp Award presented to Connor Bye for her outstanding contribution to the Club as an executive member, as a program coordinator and as a dedicated organizer of Christmas Cup.

The Club also celebrated a record number of gymnasts turning 18 during 2009!

The ACT Women's Level 10 team created history at the 2009 Australian Women's Gymnastics Championships winning the team silver medal. All six members of the team were our Club gymnasts. Club head coach Qu Derui was crowned National Coach of the Year!

Other highlights were the junior boys squad's strong results at local championships, a very enjoyable and successful overseas women's tour incorporating the 2009 Singapore Open, the club's senior WG judge achieving FIG international qualification and three highly regarded appointments: a senior Men's coach and a senior Women's coach and a Ballet coach.

For the first time in more than twenty years the Club required legal advice and conflict resolution mediation, which served to strengthen our knowledge and protective policies.

A major staff survey was conducted during term 3. Feedback was frank. The analysis presented to staff indicated a crew passionate about their involvement in gymnastics with a high regard for their colleagues, a positive morale and Club spirit, although occasionally overwhelmed by the rapid pace of recent program developments.

A new logo designed by our original graphic designer, Thuy Anh Phan, is gradually permeating our stationery and merchandise in recognition of the Club's programs for boys and girls.

## Gymnastic Results

Club gymnasts and coaches have again enjoyed excellent participation and outcomes, both locally and interstate. Results are at the end of this report and well and truly speak for themselves.

The Club continues to field maximum entries in both national and state competitions.

Retaining gymnasts to the highest levels also means that group retirements are highly likely. In this vein, we farewelled senior gymnasts: Kaitlin Dawson, Emily Glover, Melissa Orr and Keira Hopkinson. Kaitlin and Keira are now contributing to their sport through their coaching and judging qualifications. The Club is very proud of their continuing participation.

### Staff

Afternoon programs manager and GymABLE coordinator, Mary Schumacher proceeded to maternity leave and welcomed baby Toby.

We welcomed senior coaches Dmitry Berezovskiy (men), Rita Vatkina (ballet), Quanzhi Xi (women), Jenna Browne; Laura Brown; Hayley McNamara and Tara Daniel to Canberra City's coaching team. More recently, we welcomed baby Oleg Berezovskiy.

Congratulations to newly qualified and accredited Level 1 coaches: Amelia James; Kieren McNabb; Keira Hopkinson; Phillipa Dickens, Brittany Thomas, Katrina Le, Zac Streeter, Charlotte Churchill, Elyse Baldwin; Vanessa Elphick; Morgan Barnwell; The Club acknowledges the supervision and support given to aspiring coaches during their practical and theoretical work by Mary Schumacher and Laura Brown. Phillipa Dickens also has the distinction of being the first of our judges to qualify in the new Code of Points at the G-Educate Level of Intermediate.

Coaches farewelled were Naomi Nye and Mandy Barras.

A new initiative for the Club is our registration as a training provider for the 'Sport and Recreation Certificate II Apprenticeship' as undertaken by ACT College students.

### Participation Membership.

Membership numbers for 2009 reached **1138** surpassing last year's high of 1127 and represent a record enrolment and also record retention rates in the Club's Levels programs. We may attribute this to the professional coaching and office staff at the Club. *MG*, *WG*, *State & National and Recreation* programs are all showing enthusiastic participation.

#### New Programs

TeenAge Gymnastics (TAG) for boys began in term 1 this year and quickly developed a strong following under the helm of Dmitry ably assisted by Jake Silvestro.

Newly revamped Adult Gymnastics' gymnasts' participation and progress has flourished. Credit must go to coaches Geoff Munro; Keiren McNabb, Jake Silvestro and Laura Creese!

A small core of women have benefited in terms of their health, strength, flexibility and overall fitness by participating in Rita Vatkina's Mature Age Aerobics Dance (MAAD) fitness classes. The Club plans to attract more participants for 2010.

Gymnastics Australia has made some changes to its national junior women's development program for the new Olympic Cycle (2009 to 2012). The International Development Program (IDP) will now run in parallel to the National Development Program (NDP) Levels 1 to 3. Affiliated clubs have been encouraged to expand their program in the early stages. The Club has considered this carefully in consultation with our head coach and hopes to develop a fledgling IDP program in 2010.

The Club is also developing a National Level 6 ACT representative program in consultation with other major ACT Clubs and GACT. The goal is to better prepare such gymnasts for representation at Australian Championships by exposing them to available state representation competitions.

#### **GymABLE**

Our program is taking an exciting direction in 2010. Coordinator Mary Schumacher is offering GymABLE to schools at their venue. Mary and Canberra City have the full support of the Special Olympics organisation. Gymnastics Australia has recently come on board with their GymAbility program and our combined resources will provide expanded opportunities for ACT students with a disability.

#### Schools / External Programs

Programs continue to run at Charnwood and Macquaire (TEAM-Together Everyone Achieves Moregym), Gungahlin (RAGE-Recreation And Gymnastics Entertainment), 'Majura' and Lyneham. Mile Franklin PS decided to discontinue the after school program mid 2009. The Club has since assisted the school with relocation of equipment. The Aranda PS program is on hold while the school refurbishes the school halls and office area.

More recently, the Club was able to assist Gundaroo PS following an urgent request to run their during-school program for all classes. We hope that we may be able to continue providing this program in 2010.

Gymnasts in these programs are encouraged to participate in the ACT Levels 1-4 Grading competitions and the Club's Christmas Cup. Congratulations to all coaches coordinating the satellite venues! In particular to Geoff Munro who coaches at all the venues.

#### **Community**

The Club itself continues to contribute to school fetes and trivia events whenever possible and to youth education. Displays were provided during the Aranda PS 40<sup>th</sup> Year Celebrations Fete. Level 10 athletes, Brittany, Emma and Phillipa provided a display during a pharmaceutical conference held at the AIS as did the Canberra City Cheerleaders. Vouchers for free gymnastics classes were once again donated to the Majura PS fete. Our squad of Level 5 gymnasts were filmed executing routines for an Australian Sports Commission's coach education video.

Within the Club, the Canberra Diving community and the Circus Space group have continued utilising our facilities. Diving has trained through the winter on Tuesday mornings. Snow Sports ACT had a successful season of cross-training Sunday mornings during term 1. The University of Canberra's Teacher Education School doubled their class time in the gym in semesters 2 of 2008 and 2009.

We provided matting to the ANU School of Arts for an installation that required visitors to lay down for viewing and equipment to the Miles Franklin Fete. All such community assistance by our volunteers is warmly received and is a measure of the Club's Community spirit.

#### Education

Following recent accreditations the Club has a new record number of Tertiary and Gymnastics Australia qualified coaching and judging staff, including an FIG judge. Within the new Olympic cycle, we hope to add to our qualified coaching and judging ranks as new education courses are presented.

The Club values education highly and subsidises workshops and other updating opportunities - mostly from funds raised through Christmas Cup, an event where coaches and judges *donate* their time.

### Building, Infrastructure and Equipment.

Fundraising moneys and volunteer efforts have improved the Club's facilities during the period of this report. We are all most thankful for the Evaporative cooling systems to the mezzanine viewing area and which also create a gentle refreshing circulation within the gym.

We have a sturdier replacement office door (following damage during an attempted burglary) and improved security sensors throughout the facility (following the theft of a plasma screen from the kitchen).

Better drainage with a concrete pathway facing the car park has decreased the risk of flooding in the 'pit' room (flooded during National Clubs –November-2008).

Thank you to volunteers working on these projects and to the Committee for making several claims to our insurance provider.

The Club has again submitted a Capital Assistance Program (CAP) grant application to ACT Sport and Recreation to assist in our Stage 7 extension plans. Not only will this final building stage provide increased floor space, but also an improved, north facing entry and an upgrade of the car parking facilities, including surface repair and line markings. News of outcomes will not be available until early 2010.

### Office & Administration. ICT.

With increasing staff and athlete numbers there has been an increase in the administration and communications load. To provide faster processing and greater storage, the Club installed a new computer system and external back-up drive (backing up all laptop and main computer documents). We thank Eva Zhou of ATM computers for advice and provision of the new system and to volunteers for the substantial time spent installing hardware and software.

### Volunteer Efforts.

We appreciate the volunteer work of parents throughout the year with cleaning, gardening and maintenance. In particular, thanks must go to our retiring Fundraising Coordinator Donna Hopkinson for her fantastic contribution over the years!

Volunteers and fund-raising occasions continue to contribute to the Club's physical and social well being. In particular we thank the Parent Committee on subsidising the cost of the evaporative coolers as well as supporting our representative athletes with their travel.

### **Sponsorship**

Canberra City has again been offered an annual sponsorship of \$2000 from Canberra Southern Cross Club. We welcome this and continue to encourage our members to sign up with the CSCC.

#### **Financials**

The Club has transferred all staff to the superannuation provider Australian Super. The Office manager reports a simpler and more transparent web-based reporting and contributions process, as well as less management fees on staff accounts. The Club's other paperless operations utilise MYOB, COMMBIZ and the ATO taxation portal

We have also managed to re-negotiate our Workers' Compensation premiums from 4.16% of wages to 3.75%, which will be of substantial benefit.

GACT Registration, Insurance and Affiliation fees are also increasing in 2010. With all utilities' costs and usage also increasing the Committee approved a small increase in competition class fees to take effect Quarter 1. Comparison with other states indicates that we provide services at a competitively high standard on very competitive fees.

### **Auditor & Accounting**

Christine Reid & Associates have continued to provide services for the preparation of the end-of-year financial statements for presentation to company auditor Mr Roy E Priest, FCPA. Jody Moore Accounting continues to help the Club occasionally during the year.

## Referring to the financial statements.....

Although the operating surplus seems to have stabilised at what appears a grand amount we should note that the Liabilities. Furthermore, loan interest changes from 8.5% to 8.75% back up to the original 9% this month, give some concern. Our continued high repayments have reduced our exposure to these fluctuations. The loan balance as of today is \$209000 compared with \$402000 reported 30<sup>th</sup> June 2008. Following the December SLISS (Sports Loan Interest Subsidy Scheme) claim, we aim to have the loan balance to below \$200000. The new committee will then need to consider the delay or not of future extension plans with or without CAP grant success!

Throughout, our *Not-for-Profit* charter has been a priority and the Committee has taken every opportunity to re-invest in Club infrastructure and resources for *all* current members' and participants' benefit.

#### In conclusion....

The above report to members provides a snapshot of Club decisions, events, contributions and outcomes.

Ongoing for the new committee will be the review and renewal of procedures and policies as well as the opportunity to submit an application for Star 4 **Club 10** accreditation!




