### **3. President's Report**

The 2012 calendar year saw the Committee focus on financial management, the structure of the Club's programs, seeking suitable staff for our programs and supporting the maintenance of the Club's facilities. Club representatives also served on Gymnastics ACT's Board and Men's and Women's Technical Committees, which have all been busy with delivering new initiatives of Gymnastics Australia and Gymnastics ACT. Particularly exciting will be the enhancement of the GfA (Gymnastics for All) program and a return to gymnastics display teams performing locally, interstate and overseas.

The financial year saw a couple of rate cuts, which continue to benefit the Club while we still have our loan. Considering this and the Club's satisfactory position, the Committee approved a 3% salary increase for staff in 2013.

The Parent Fundraising and Activities sub-committee continued to be active this year, organizing an extensive chocolate sales drive and events such as: Easter and Mother's Day Raffles; Halloween Disco; End of Year Celebration. I cannot underestimate the value of these activities both for their fundraising goals as well as their building of club spirit.

More details regarding the Club's activities follow.

#### ***Gymnastic Events & Results***

The 2012 Gymsports' year has been dominated by the Olympic Games in the sense that all events' calendars were reorganized to fit in with early trials and championships. Coaches and senior gymnasts hit the ground training early in the year, while junior athletes had somewhat longer to wait for their events.

CCGC has once again enjoyed strong participation numbers during GACT's competition and awards season. In particular, 119 gymnasts, including a GymAble student, entered the ACT Levels 1 to 4 (GfA) Grading day!

The Club's national competition stream was particularly successful this year being the Women's Champion ACT Club at L1, L2 and L3, as well as boasting the Overall ACT Champions at Levels 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9! The Men's Levels 1 to 3 team achieved an Overall Second place. This and senior athletes attending Australian Championships is a substantial achievement for our still developing program. Congratulations are extended to the coaches and gymnasts.

We held many events on behalf of Gymnastics ACT both for competition and education. I am proud to report that the Club received very positive feedback regarding our hospitality and venue.

More detailed results may be found at the end of this report.

#### ***Staff & Education***

The Club welcomed Rob Riddell and Anna Hill. Rob has assisted with management of the afternoon programs, worked in the office and assisted with maintenance. Anna has represented the Club as an Advanced judge.

Farewelled were: Quanzhi Xi – one of the Club's senior Women's coaches. Quanzhi departed to take up a position with the Men's High Performance program in Sydney.

The Club values education highly and subsidises workshops and other updating opportunities.

### ***Participation Membership & Growth***

Membership numbers for 2012 reached **1149**, an increase on last year's final figure and our highest yet. We may attribute this to the coaching, supervising and office staff at the Club both at Belconnen and at our school venues. **MG, WG, State & National and Recreation** programs are showing enthusiastic participation and good retention rates. In particular the junior classes fill up very quickly and have waiting lists at the start of each term.

The Committee feels that we have reached a space maximum and, despite staggering some classes to start later during this year, we still look forward to opportunities to expand to suitable facilities.

### ***Schools / External Programs***

As inner Belconnen schools' enrolments are increasing once again, space for gymnastics programs is becoming less available. However, our remaining program at Lyneham is enjoying maximum participation. A small program at Queanbeyan Public School, started in Term 3, has also reached a maximum level of participation in relation to space and coach availability.

The Club's two day program in Gungahlin, run at Amaroo School, has been particularly successful this year (approximately 70 gymnasts each afternoon) and coaches will trial a further expansion in 2013, although the Club has been asked to move. Staff are investigating Harrison School as the alternative venue – as recommended by Sport and Recreation services and Amaroo school itself. Currently we are considering a request from GACT and Queanbeyan YMCA to provide After School gymnastics activities early in 2013.

The Club continues to provide and maintain suitable equipment for these programs.

Schools gymnasts are encouraged to participate in the ACT Levels 1-4 Grading competitions and the Club's Christmas Cup.

### ***Community***

Education Venue: GA Level 2 Coaching Course; GA/NSW Rebound Therapy Practitioner Training Course, GA Professional Development Day – ACT Primary School Teachers; Stacey Umeh (National Choreographer) MG and WG Artistic Workshops; Goulburn PCYC assistance with Coach Accreditation

The Club continues to fulfil its role as a Community venue. We currently have up to 200 participants using-hiring the facility on some kind of regular basis. Groups are:

Cheerleading and fitness; year round  
Canberra Diving Academy; Dry-land training;  
Circus Space; year round;  
University of Canberra School of Teacher Education; semester two – August to November  
Our Holiday Program, which is open to the community.

The Club contributes voucher prizes and, occasionally equipment, to school fetes and trivia events. This year we provided Hawker PS fete and St Monica's Trivia evening with vouchers as prizes and Miles Franklin with equipment for their fete.

### ***Building, Infrastructure, Equipment, Image***

Following the completion of the Stage 7 extension, the Club has commissioned or finished some further minor works such as the west end high bar pit edging; east and south fire door repairs; new signage; south roof leaks; installation of matting under the uneven bar pits.

Landscaping or planting is still a project needing some willing volunteers.

Further discussions with the builder and Men's coaches, has confirmed the best site for another pit installation is the east end of the gym.

### ***Financials***

At all times, the management pursues avenues to maintain quality programs and infrastructure for coaches and gymnasts at reasonable cost while aiming to achieve a 'not-for-profit' result.

We are also required to fulfil our GACT affiliation responsibilities, which we understand will be allocated differently for 2013. Registrations fees are also advised to be different

Our persistence in repaying our loan, despite a couple of redraws, has reduced the balance to \$190,000 as of last week and we are on track to amortize the loan at the end of 2016 if not before.

The Committee is aware that our Superannuation Guarantee Contribution on behalf of staff will begin slowly increasing from July 2013 (9% to 9.25%).

### ***Auditor & Accounting***

Christine Reid & Associates have provided accounting services and prepared the end-of-year financial statements for presentation to the company auditor, Matthew Walker of Ledger & Walker.

Some changes as to requirement for a Company Auditor are being considered for Not-for-Profit Incorporated Associations, however we will await advice on this matter, which would impact on the Club's accounting fees.

***Referring to the financial statements.....***

It is pleasing to see all positive indicators. The solid operating profit will help the club contribute to the minor building works with confidence.

***In conclusion.....***

I would like to thank the outgoing Committee Members for all their hard work and enthusiasm.

I wish the new Committee renewed energy to tackle the new Olympic Cycle with its new programs and opportunities, as well as all that is required to maintain and enhance Canberra City Gymnastics Club!

The Club looks forward to your continued support and contribution.
